

"VI INTERCLUBS PAIRS TROPHY ACGCBCV 2026"

PARTICIPANTS:

All amateur players with a valid license issued by the RFEG **and are annual members of any of the courses attached to the Association of Golf Courses of the Costa Blanca and the Valencia Region (ACGCBCV)** may take part, regardless of whether the course where you are a member, hosts a competition of the circuit. The courses that do not have members may designate federated players for said courses. The subscribers of the Elche Golf School of the FGCV - a collaborating entity of the circuit - will also be able to participate.

Other amateur players with a valid license issued by the RFEG who do not meet the requirement of being annual members of any of the courses belonging to the ACGCBCV **may also participate**, competing for a different prize as specified in the "PRIZES" section of these regulations.

Minors may play with the authorization of a parent/legal guardian and must play the events with an adult as a pair. Players under 14 years old may only participate in pairs with a parent/legal guardian.

The ACGCBCV, through the collaborating entities, will provide a gift (welcome pack) for each player in the **first 5 competitions** that each couple plays.

FORMAT:

FOURBALL STABLEFORD HANDICAP, except for the Foressos (25th April) and Costa de Azahar (17th May) competitions, which will be played under the **CANADA CUP** format (18 holes, STABLEFORD HANDICAP PAIRS, sum of the team's two scorecards. Format: Canada Cup).

TEES, TEE TIMES, TESTS WITH 2 ROUNDS, REFEREES:

- **Tees;** Red for Ladies and Yellow for Gentlemen
- **Tee Times:** Determined by the Circuit Committee and the course where each competition is contested.
- **Tests with 2 rounds:** In the event that any circuit test consists of 2 rounds, players registered for the 2nd round will not be allowed to practice on the course during the 1st round. Failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification.
- **Referees:** events held under the CANADA CUP format will be officiated by an FGCV referee.

REGISTRATION:

The registration process for each couple has the following steps:

1.- GENERAL REGISTRATION FEE FOR THE CIRCUIT (Prerequisite to be able to register for any of the events of the circuit):

1.1- The members of the pair must access the ACGCBCV website and click on the button "**REGISTER**" or click here directly: <https://main.dgcerexzb4vu3.amplifyapp.com/#/>.

1.2- Then, each member of the pair must **fill in their own personal details**. Registrations with repeated data for both players (email, telephone, etc.) will not be valid.

1.3- Once the details of both players have been filled in, the general registration fee for the pair's circuit will be paid, with the following options:

- **NO LIMIT: 45€ per player;** valid to play the 13 tournaments of the circuit.
- **From 1 to 6 ROUNDS: 30€ per player;** valid for a maximum of 6 tournaments of the circuit to be selected by each pair. If after playing 6 tests you wish to participate in any other, you must renew your registration by paying an additional €25 per player to have access to the rest of the tests without limitation.
- **1 ROUND: 10€ per player.**

1.4- The payment will be confirmed instantly with the **purchase receipt** (simplified invoice) at the email address provided. By making the purchase through our online platform, you accept the terms and conditions detailed at the time of formalizing the payment of registration.

1.5- Each player must check that their details appear correctly in the "**REGISTERED LIST**" published in the same section of the website.

2.- INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION FOR EACH ROUND (Before each round):

Once the general registration for the circuit has been completed (previous step), each pair will process their registration for each test directly with the courses. No pair can be registered in a test if it has not previously made the general registration through the website of the ACGCBCV and appears in the "list of registered" mentioned above.

Each host course will designate the number of places for members of other courses. Enrolments will be made in strict order of registration.

The individual registration fee for each tournament of the circuit will be:

- between **40€ and 45€ per round for pairs formed by members of the same ACGCBCV course**, €40 for the 9-hole courses and €45 for the 18-hole courses.
- between **€50 and €65 per round for the rest of participants**, 50€ on the 3 9-hole courses and at the discretion of each 18-hole course.

CATEGORIES:

- 1st Category: sum of exact handicaps up to 30,0
- 2nd Category: sum of exact handicaps starting at 30,1

Valid handicaps will be **those in force in the first competition that is played**, the players remaining in the same category throughout the circuit. In each test, the player shall compete with his current handicap at that time. **The Competitions Committee may adjust the handicaps valid for competing in circuit events in the case of repeated very high scores by a pair without any adjustment to their handicap.**

For the purposes of the competition and the allocation of the pairs category, a player with an exact handicap greater than **26,4** will register with the exact handicap limited to **26,4**

PRIZES:

1.- EACH COMPETITION FOR ALL PARTICIPATING PAIRS:

- The 1st pair classified in each category will receive a prize, each member of the pair obtaining a **commemorative flag** with the logo of the 18th hole of the host course where said competition was played. If a winning pair in an event has previously won, the prize will automatically be raffled off amongst all the pairs taking part in that event.
- There will be special prizes in all the tests of the circuit (e.g. closest to the pin contest)

2.- FINAL RANKING OF THE CIRCUIT **FOR MEMBERS OF THE SAME COURSE OF THE ACGCBCV:**

- 1st pair classified in both categories (4 players in total): **Trophy + annual subscription** (from 15/Nov'26 to 14/Nov'27) in all the courses that host a test (see section "Calendar").
- 2nd pair classified in both categories (4 players in total): **Trophy + 6 months subscription** (from 15/Nov'26 until 14/May'27) in all courses that host a test (see section "Calendar").
- 3rd pair classified in both categories (4 players in total): **Trophy + 3 months subscription** (from 15/Nov'26 until 14/Feb'27) in all the courses that host a test (see section "Calendar")
- 4th pair classified in both categories (4 players in total): **Trophy + 2 months subscription** (from 15/Nov'26 until 14/Jan'27) in all courses that host a test (see section "Calendar").
- 5th pair classified in both categories (4 players in total): **Trophy + 1 month subscription** (from 15/Nov'26 until 14/Dec'27) in all courses that host a test (see section "Calendar").

Explanatory notes on these prizes:

1. *To avail of a prize, the player will have to keep the annual subscription or membership fee in force in their current course throughout the entire duration of the prize. The non-renewal of said*

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subscription / membership fee would automatically cancel the awarded prize.

- 2. The winners will have the right to play under the same conditions as the members of each participating courses, which includes paying the subscriber green fee in the courses. Tournaments are not included, except for IPT circuit tests.*
- 3. Apart from being able to play under the same conditions as the members, it does not include any other special offers (discounts, limited access, etc.)*
- 4. The first valid day to enjoy the subscriptions obtained with the prizes will be November 15th, 2026, and this date cannot be modified, extended or postponed under any circumstances.*
- 5. Players must be members or annual subscribers of the same ACGCBCV course and up to date with the payment of their fees, regardless of whether their course hosts an event or not. The annual members of the Elche Golf School of the FGCV -a collaborating entity of the circuit- will also be able to participate.*

3.- FINAL RANKING FOR THE REST OF THE PAIRS (NOT MEMBERS OF THE SAME ACGCBCV COURSE).

The pairs participating in the circuit whose members are not annual members of the same course of the ACGCBCV, will compete in their corresponding category opting for these prizes:

- o 1st pair classified in both categories (4 players in total): **Voucher of 2 GFs of each course where a test of the circuit has been played** (see section "Calendar"). These vouchers will be valid for **1 year** (from 15/Nov'26 to 14/Nov'27 subject to availability).
- o 2nd pair classified in both categories (4 players in total): **Voucher of 2 GFs of each course where a test of the circuit has been played** (see section 'Calendar'). These vouchers will be valid for **6 months** (from 15/Nov'26 to 14/May'27 subject to availability).
- o 3rd couples classified in both categories (4 players in total): **Voucher of 2 GFs of each course where a test of the circuit has been played (see section 'Calendar')**. These vouchers will be valid for **3 months** (from 15/Nov'26 to 14/Feb'27 subject to availability).

If a pair of players enters the tournament in the non-member category (at that moment both players are not members or annual subscribers of the same ACGCBCV course), but during the course of the circuit both become members or annual subscribers of the same ACGCBCV course, they will continue to compete in the same non-member category, but paying the members GF.

4.- SPECIAL COURSE PRIZE: The winner of the 2026 edition will be the course belonging to the ACGCBCV that obtains the highest cumulative score among the **first 2 pairs classified by category** in the cumulative general classification (a maximum of 4 pairs per course). The winning course will have a **plaque with its name** on the "**IPT Trophy**" which will be displayed in its Club House for one year, until there is a new winning course in the next edition of the circuit.

- **HISTORIC Winners: 2021 ALENDA, 2022 ESCORPIÓN, 2023 FONT DEL LLOP, 2024 EL SALER, 2025 EL BOSQUE**

5.- FINAL DRAW OF THE CIRCUIT FOR ALL PARTICIPATING PAIRS:

5.1.- Among all pairs (members and non-members of the ACGCBCV) who have participated in a **minimum of 7 tournaments** of the circuit **and register (both partners) through a form providing their details and accepting the terms and conditions of the draw**, will be drawn, among others, the following prizes:

- **2 VOUCHERS TO THE CARIBBEAN / CASA DE CAMPO resort & villas:** including a **cheque** for a total amount of **€2,000** (to be divided between the 2 vouchers and not exchangeable for cash).

Valid for any date and destination. The cheque is valid until 31st December 2027. For further details please contact Transvia Viajes Alicante (Telf. 965 143 950). This prize will include **2 Vouchers** (one for each winner) at 'Casa de Campo resort & villas' valued at **6.000 US\$ between the 2 of them, each one consisting of:**

- 4 nights/5 days stay for 2 people in an Elite Room
 - Daily breakfast at the resort selected restaurants
 - 1 round of golf per person on "Dye Fore" course, designed by the golf legend Pete Dye
 - 1 buggy for transportation within the Resort
 - Unlimited use of the fitness center
- **1 motorcycle model NX2 from NEXT Motors** valued at approx. **€2,500**. NEXT Motors will carry out the draw **among all players who, once a minimum of 8 rounds of the circuit have been played**, register through the aforementioned form.
 - **Other prizes to be confirmed.**

COMPETITION GENERAL RULES FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS IN THE CIRCUIT

To be ranked and qualify for the general awards described in any category of the "PRIZES" section, the following conditions must be met:

- *In the overall ranking a minimum of 4 competitions is required. There is no limit to the number of competitions that can be entered by each pair, counting the **4 best accumulated results** of all those obtained.*
- *It is a requirement to always maintain the same composition of the pair, which could be mixed. You may change a playing partner, but this partnership will start with zero points.*
- *In case of long-term injury to one member of the pair, the injured player may be replaced (only one replacement per pair throughout the circuit), as long as a medical certificate is provided and the new player has a handicap at the time of the change that allows the pair to remain in the same category in which they started the circuit.*
- *When a pair competes in the members' category and one of the members ceases to be a member/subscriber of the course, the pair will automatically compete in the non-members' category, maintaining the number of events played and the ranking points. Similarly, they will no longer appear in the course rankings.*

PUNCTUATION SYSTEM

COMPETITIONS: A scoring system is established for **each competition** based on the following criteria, by category:

	9 tournaments	4 tournaments: 2 Canada Cup tournaments_ and <u>last 2 tournaments (*)</u>
1 st Classified Pair:	25 Points	35 Points
2 nd Classified Pair:	22 Points	30 Points
3 rd Classified Pair:	20 Points	27 Points

5 th Classified Pair:	15 Points	19 Points
6 th Classified Pair:	12 Points	16 Points



7 th Classified Pair:	10 Points	13 Points
8 th Classified Pair:	7 Points	10 Points

10 th Classified Pair:	2 Points	5 Points

(*) If, due to weather conditions or force majeure, the initially scheduled order of the tests must be changed, the last two tests to be held will have the highest score.

- **Order of equal results**: the RFEG Green Book for Handicap tests will be used to resolve ties or disputes.
- **Points for the last 2 tests**: the last 2 tests only award ranking points to those pairs who are able to complete the minimum 4 tests required to qualify for prizes.
- **Incidents in the classifications of the events and the rankings**: any possible incident or error that the players appreciate in the management and classification of the tests, must be communicated directly to the course where the event has been played. If the incidence was in the rankings, then it must be communicated to the ACGCBCV.
- **Incidents in the registrations to the tests / inscription to the circuit**: any incident related to the **registration to each test**, must be communicated directly to the course where the event is going to take place. If the incident was in the general registration to the circuit, then it must be communicated to the ACGCBCV.

FINAL RANKING: the **4 best scores of the 13 possible** will score.

- **In the event of a tie in the Final Ranking**: the pair with **the most disputed events** will be the winner. In the case of having contested the same number of tests, the tie will be resolved in favour of the pair with the **lowest total handicaps** in the last tournament played. If after applying the above criteria the tie persists, then it will be resolved with the 5th best test, 6th, and so on until the tie is resolved. If the tie persists, it will be resolved by lottery.
- **In the event of a tie in the Special Course Prize**: the criteria as above will be used to resolve, ("tie in the final ranking"), specifying that these criteria will be applied to the **4 pairs that contribute points to each course** (the 2 best pairs of each category) in the final ranking.

Competition Committee:

At each venue, it will be formed by the Competition Committee of the course where the competition is held, which will resolve all doubts arising from these regulations.

CIRCUIT COMMITTEE, formed by:

- Mr. Salvador Lucas Lozano, president of the ACGCBCV and president of this Committee
- Mr. Alfredo Martinez, president of the Rules Committee FGCV

- Mr. Angel Llopes Molina, Managing Director of the ACGCBCV

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This committee will resolve any other eventualities not covered in the above regulations. The committee's decision is final and, in the event of a tie between the opinions of its members, the chair of the committee shall have the casting vote.

The Circuit Committee reserves the right to modify these regulations at any time, in which case they will be updated and published on the Association's website. In case of any doubt regarding the translations of these regulations into other languages, this original Spanish version shall prevail.
